Phenolics are a group of chemical compounds that affect the wine's colour, texture, astringency and bitterness. Smaller phenolics can taste bitter, or develop bitter tastes on oxidation. Anthocyanins are responsible for red wine colour and are generally found in pulp cells directly underneath the skins of black grapes.
